UPDATES TO PROTOCOL FOR CHALLENGES

CHALLENGING A QUESTION:

TEAMS NEED TO MAKE CHALLENGES AFTER THE QUESTION HAS BEEN ASKED. IF A TEAM DECLARES THEY WILL CHALLENGE A QUESTION DURING THE BATTLE, THE MODERATOR WILL ASK IF THE TEAM WOULD STILL LIKE TO CHALLENGE THE ANSWER TO THE QUESTION AT THE END OF THE BATTLE.

NO POINTS WILL BE TAKEN FROM A TEAM BASED ON A CHALLENGE.

THE SPOKESPERSON CAN ONLY SHOW THE BOOK PASSAGE WITH THE ANSWER. THE SPOKESPERSON CAN NOT EXPLAIN THEIR ANSWER AND WHY IT IS CORRECT.

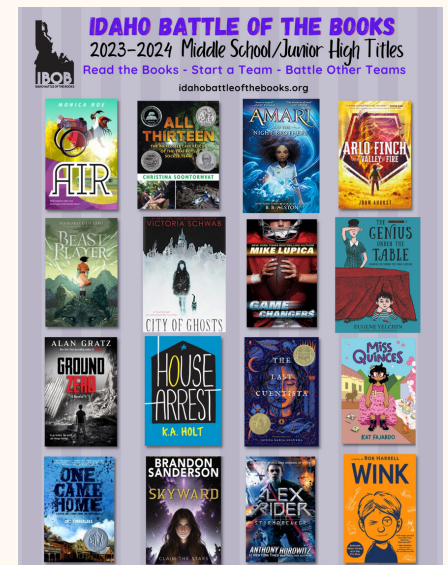
