The details:

- 4 people per team (1 alternate is allowed)
- You will name your team.
- Books can be loaned out by the school library, public library, or bought on your own.
- Your team can meet as often as you want. There will be some specific library times for activities and meetings.
- As a team, you decide how to read the books. You can read all 16, you can split them up, etc. No one is required to read a book if they do not want to read it.
- Teams will read the books during the fall and winter, and in January, school battles will start.
- The questions will be "in which book" or "content" questions. You will have 15 seconds to discuss the answer and the team spokesperson will give the answer.
- You will have the chance to answer the other team's question if they do not know it.
- Selected team(s) will go to the district or regional competition in **Spring 2025**, if one is held in my region. If a region does not hold a competition, teams from that region may request to participate in a neighboring regional competition.
- Teams advancing from a district competition will be invited to participate in a regional competition.

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
